PHASE 2 CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Phase 1 Construction is completed. The National Park Service and Federal Highway Administration want to thank you for your patience during Phase 1 construction and hope that visitors to the Marin Headlands enjoy all of the improvements.

Phase 2 construction will begin in 2013 and is anticipated to be complete late 2014.

Construction Activities for Phase 2 include:

- Finish replacing asphalt on Field Road
- Reconstruction of the Alexander Avenue & W. Bunker Road (Danes Drive) intersection
- Reconstruction of wetlands and removal of Fort Cronkhite Dirt Overflow Lot
- Restoring the Fort Cronkhite Annex Parade Ground Quarry to better match historic site conditions
- Construction of the Smith Road Parking Lot and Fort Cronkhite Parking Lot
- Resurfacing, restoration, and rehabilitation of Old Bunker Road, Mitchell Road, and Bunker Road (intersection of Old Bunker Road/ Mitchell Road to the Baker-Barry Tunnel)
- Construction of the Fort Cronkhite Annex Parking Lot near the Marine Mammal Center
- Guardrail replacement at East Bunker Road
